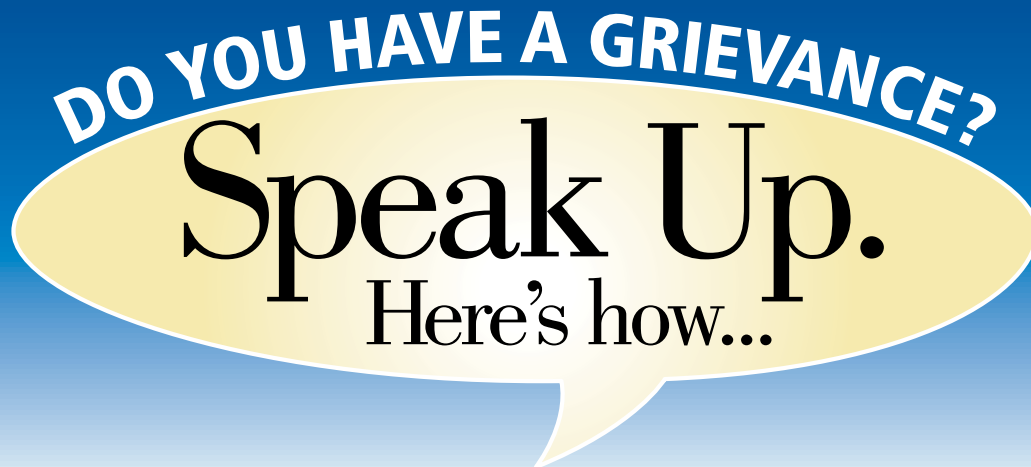


The treatment you receive should meet your need for safety, your rights as a patient, clinical standards of care, and be provided by staff who treat you fairly and respectfully.
