

Peritoneal Dialysis

Pot o' Gold!

- Peritoneal Catheter-flexible tube placed in lower abdomen to allow fluid to exit and enter the peritoneum
- Blood is filtered naturally using tiny blood vessels in the lining of your abdomen (peritoneum)
- Can preserve residual renal function
- Less trips to the Dialysis Clinic
- No needles, No Blood!

Flexibility-You Choose how to time your treatments

Independence
You can do peritoneal dialysis (PD) at home while still having regular monitoring and phone access to a 24/7 on-call PD nurse.

Gentler on your body
PD is considered to be easier on your body, including your heart. You may experience fewer side effects than with other forms of dialysis.



Can be done in any clean environment-home, work, traveling

Can be done throughout day or overnight

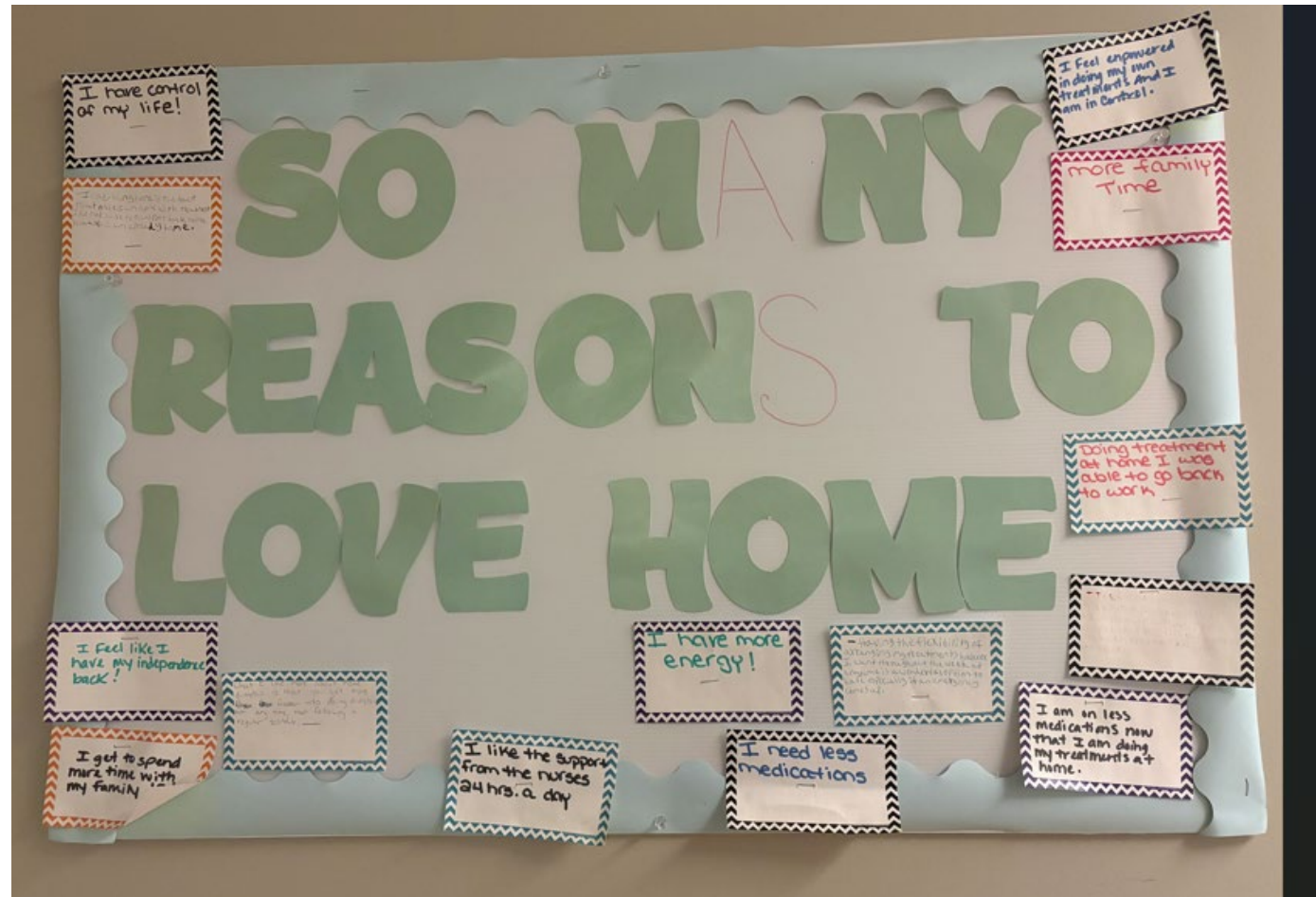
